Bonxie: Register and Rules

Bonxie is a Single Sculling Vessel which may be used only by permission of, and under supervision by, a GCRC Club Skipper

On Club Days, rowing session limited to 20 minutes; at other times 45 minutes.

At all times, Bonxie's range is restricted to:

- Upriver: The Canting Basin
- Downriver: BAE Basin

Apart from our usual safety rules, also carry a mobile phone, switched on, to use if assistance required.

Before session, obtain permission from Skipper, collect oars and rowlocks from clubhouse, sign, date and time in book.

After session, unless handing over to waiting GCRC Member, return oars and rowlocks to clubhouse, sign out, note time and any comments/damage report.

Particularly on return to pontoon, best practice may be to put fenders out, safely tie up at south end, disembark and lead the vessel by mooring rope to its berth where it can be securely tied off.
