1. Resuming Rowing/Covid Officer

Shona Henderson has agreed to take on the role of Covid Officer and she and FMcL did a risk assessment on the pontoon which will be shared with the Committee for approval. SH will also laminate signage for the pontoon. FMcL will inform members of this process and when rowing will then recommence.

Rowing sessions will then be posted on Eventbrite and all crew members must register via Eventbrite.

The Committee and the Covid Officer to monitor the ongoing restrictions and act accordingly and the Covid Officer will monitor the cleaning equipment required on an ongoing basis.

2. AGM

Gregor from Seaforce Marine is investigating the purchase of a Portaloo. He is also looking at rearranging the pontoon and making better use of it which could benefit the club.

IW and FMcL have cleared debris from the pontoon.
