### **Agenda**

#### **1. Matters arising from previous minutes**

Further to a meeting with Colin Botfield and David Denholm, FMcL and IW sent a draft berthing agreement to CMT. As yet there has been no formal reply. There will be space for one berth only at a cost of £500 for this year and £1000 per year thereafter.

Bonxie has been returned to the Clyde Windsurfing Club at Lochwinnoch.

#### **2. Finance Report**

There is still a healthy surplus in the bank but due to future berthing fees the club will have to look at fundraising and grant applications.

Membership stands at 69 down from 77 last year which is a good result in the current circumstances.

RR is reviewing the 2020-21 accounts.

#### **3. Skiffs Status Report**

IW and GMcC checked on the skiffs and barge recently. Some ballast and heavy paint tins were moved and the barge came up a bit, so it might be a ballast issue, not water.

There is an issue with Gobhancroit's rudder and a photo has been sent to BB. Lady Danger is the only active skiff.

All 3 covers are in the west wing but not to be used at the moment.

The old oars are being used until PA informs us of the status of the new oars.

Kelvin Kelpie needs some attention.

Ongoing maintenance needs to be addressed as a matter of priority if full rowing is to commence. No-one has come forward to take the lead.

#### **4. AOB**

There were some issues with the booking system. IW will investigate. and if anyone is aware of a better system please inform the committee.

If non-members or friends of members try to book on a session they should be informed that this is not possible at the moment.

RR said the Covid protocol was working well and there was no issue with lack of toilet facilities.

Date of COP 26 restrictions are still not known.

The committee will keep an eye on the construction of the new bridge to see if there are any opportunities and restrictions.
