Minutes

1. Matters arising from previous minutes

FMcL contacted AA regarding the covering of the skiffs.

2. Finance Report

The club's finances remain healthy and the membership stands at 76.

3. Restarting of open rowing

Some skippers have enquired when sessions can be offered to non members and it was agreed that, as the rowing sessions are showing waitlists, this issue will be revisited after COP 26.

4. Maintenance Report

Thanks were expressed to LD for presenting a maintenance audit (now on our website <https://rowglasgow.org.uk/maintenance-and-repairs/>) and to all members who helped with the cleaning and covering of the skiffs last week.

Members were invited to report any issues they are aware of to be added to the audit (please email repairs@rowglasgow.org.uk).

Painting of the barge will now take place next spring.

Remaining cover to be attached, moorings checked and any club equipment put in the barge on Monday 11th October.

GMcC and LD will do an inventory of maintenance equipment after COP 26.

GMcC suggested that we should consider using water containers as a safer and easier ballast method on the barge, which will be considered after COP 26.

The need for long term storage of the trailer is still outstanding.

RR sent a comprehensive report on safety whilst working on the barge, which FMcL will condense and distribute.

BB has dowelled and glued the broken oar and will carry out similar preventive work on the other oars.

5. Merchandising

IW will establish costs of merchandise and gauge interest from members.

6. AOB

AMcD informed the club that Gal Gael and Seaforce intend to remove their vessels from the pontoon during COP 26.

We are not in a position to remove the skiffs now, however FMcL met with Fire and Rescue who will be present 24/7 during COP 26 and will keep an eye on things.

FMcL has placed club contact details on the pontoon so they can contact if any issues occur.
